comfortable /'kʌm.fə.tə.bəl/ ≠ uncomfortable

- *The sofa is very comfortable.*
- *These shoes are really uncomfortable.*
- *He ate too much and felt uncomfortable.*

crowded ≠ uncrowded

delicious = yummy, tasty, mouth-watering ≠ yucky, tasteless

- *This cake is really delicious.*

friendly ≠ unfriendly

- *Jack is a friendly boy.*
- *He speaks in a friendly way.*

horrible = very bad, awful, terrible

- *That was a horrible thing to say!*

pleasant = enjoyable ≠ unpleasant

- *It was pleasant to sit down after standing for hours.*

terrible ≠ terrific

terrible = very bad

- *The weather was terrible.*

terrific = very good

- *You look terrific!*
