Adverbs of Degree

degree = the amount, level, or extent

Small Degree => a little, slightly, a bit

Medium Degree => rather, fairly, quite, pretty

Strong Degree => very, really, so, extremely, absolutely, completely

medium = average; halfway between small and strong

Point:

We use adverbs of degree before adjectives or adverbs of manner.

Examples:

Adverb of Degree + Adjective

Examples:

Michael is a little happy.

Sally is quite happy.

Robert is very happy.

Adverb of Degree + Adverb of Manner

Examples:

Tom sang the song a bit happily.

Jack sang the song rather happily.

Mary sang the song so happily.
