At a Garage

garage = a place where a mechanic repairs cars
garage = a place in the house where you park your car

Mr. Hopkins is at a garage because his car needs repair.

need sth => *Mr. Hopkins's car needs repair.*

need to do sth => *Mr. Hopkins needs to repair his car.*

repair (n.) = fixing, mending

repair (v.) = fix, mend



out of order = faulty = broken = out of whack

➤ *The brake lights of his car are out of order.*

Shall I check anything else? = May I check anything else?



No need. = There is no need to do that.

by five o'clock = before 5 o'clock



depend on = count on, rely on

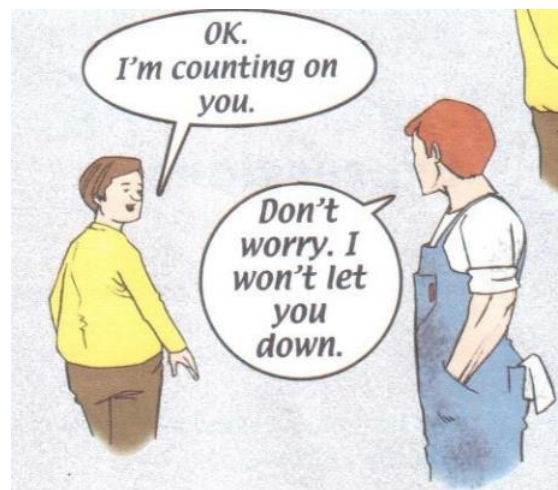
definitely = sure, certainly
